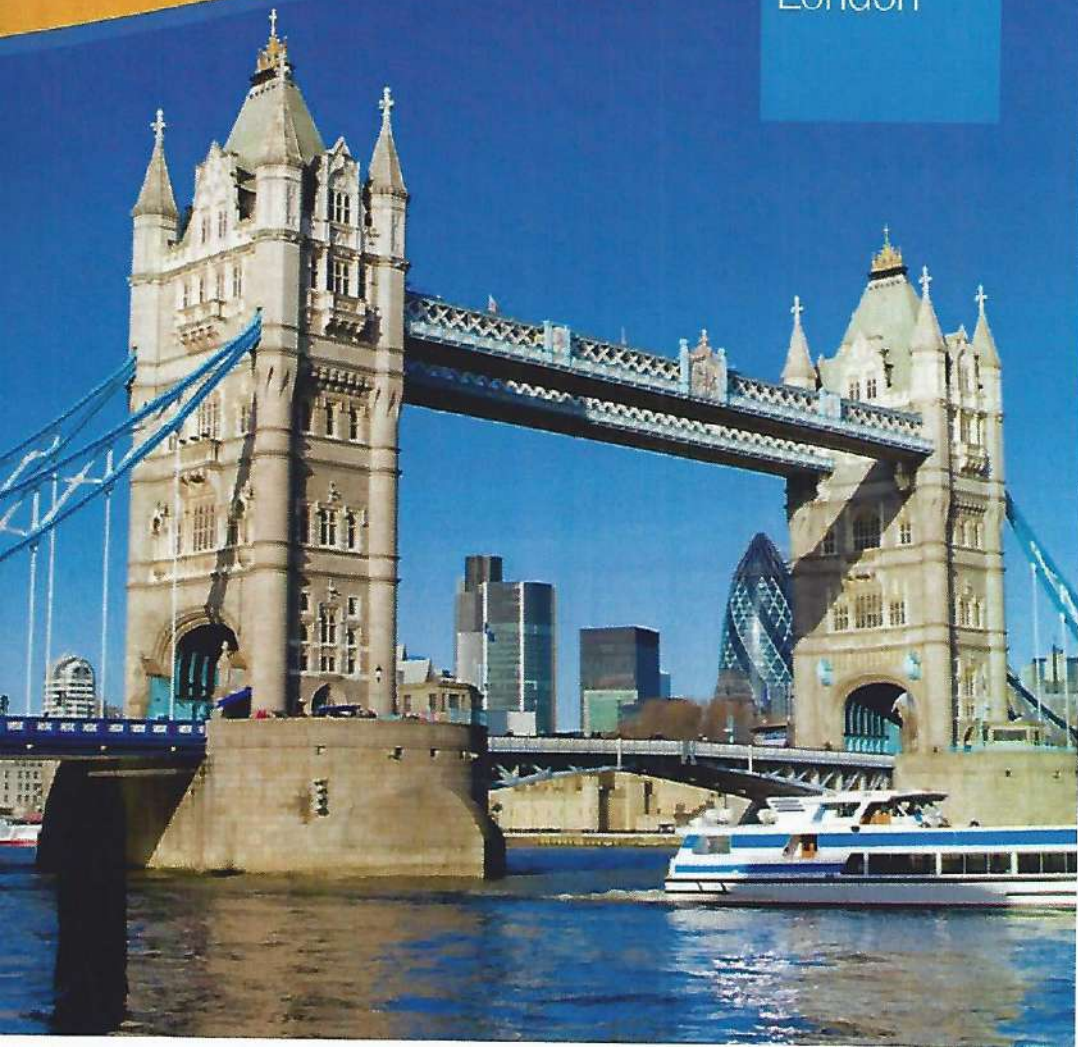

Faculty of Science, Engineering and Computing

The Faculty of Science, Engineering and Computing (SEC) at Kingston University, is comprised of three schools, bringing together interdisciplinary research, improving the scope of the student experience and encouraging partnerships between academia and commerce.

Through this collaborative approach, the Faculty offers access to these resources, knowledge and information as well as a broader perspective on its courses, with teaching and research staff working more closely with their colleagues in other disciplines. Students benefit from a practice-based education informed by innovative research and with use of world-class modern testing facilities. The faculty provides some of the state-of-the-art infrastructure: dedicated suites and workspaces, IT facilities, social areas, researchers and industry.

Library and Learning Services

The Penrhyn Road and Sir Sydney Camm Centre provides services for the SEC Faculty and are open 24 hours a day during term time, and gives students access to libraries, study spaces and computer facilities. A wide range of resources, including texts, periodicals, journals, newspapers, loan laptops and e-resources are available.

Sports

The University has excellent facilities for outdoor sports including rugby, football, cricket, archery, netball and tennis to a range of other sporting facilities by linking up with local organizations and clubs. The fitness centre at Penrhyn Road campus features a modern 65-station gymnasium. Kingston is a hub for sports-loving students as its sports facilities comprises of 40 sports clubs, sports and fitness centres. The students are also given access to the same.

Social Initiatives

With an annual budget of almost £203million and more than 2,000 staff, Kingston University is one of the town's largest employers and makes a significant contribution to the national economy. The staff and students are active in the local community through an award winning volunteering scheme wherein 300 volunteers offer 3,500 hours of service for a cause annually. The scheme gives volunteers a platform to work regularly in schools, charities and community groups.

Careers and Employability Service (CES)

Kingston's Careers and Employability team delivers front-line services to students via both individual and group activities. From offering guidance and supporting students in identifying their skills, to helping students through the application process (CV, applications, interviews and assessment) - covering huge amount of practice-based topics. CES also has internet resources to help international students look for employment opportunities in their own countries. Kingston University has concrete links to local, national and international business and industry as many teaching staff are working professionals.

Top University for Graduate Start-ups

Kingston University has, for the 6th time, topped the table for graduate business start-ups, according to the latest figures released by the Higher Education Statistics Agency. The data also shows that the approximate, combined turnover of all the University's business start-ups currently stands at just under £30 million, which accounts for 5.50% of the total turnover generated by all active graduates' start-ups across the country.

Admission Procedure

Entry Requirements

The minimum entry qualifications for the programme are

- **Diploma**- Students would enter the course after having successfully completed approved Indian Diploma Curriculum, with a minimum of first class award
- **English Language Proficiency** - a minimum of IELTS Score of 6.0 (min 5.5. in all components) or 12th Std. in India of any Recognised Board with a minimum of 70% or equivalent is required.

Candidates must pass the selection process at SVKM, which includes assessment of application form and a personal interview.

Documents required to be submitted

The following documents are required to be submitted along with the application form:

- Copy of Pan Card and Copy of Aadhar Card
- Copy of Valid Passport
- Copy of the Diploma engineering examination & diploma certificate
- Leaving certificate of the last attended institution (Original)
- Copy of Certificates proving the required English proficiency
- Duly filled Identity Application form along with two Passport photographs
- Duly signed IIS rule book

Note: The originals of above mentioned documents must be produced at the time of admission.
